Executive Summary

Grand Industries hubs three different divisions. Owned by Steve Grand, the company houses companies in the healthcare industry including CK Dental Industries (dental biologics and surgical instrumentation), G3 Biologics (orthopedic products for the medical industry) and Medasend Biomedical (a distributor of medical waste management products for the healthcare industry).



Steve Grand has been in the dental device industry over 20 years. He was the lead executive who was responsible for increasing Lifecore Biomedical's implant sales; the company sold for \$239 million to Warburg Pincus in 2008. Grand was 100% equity share holder of Medadent Biomedical. He carved out Medasend division and in 2006 sold Medadent to Stericycle. Grand acquired CK Dental in 2008.
